Resilience

Interact with and form lasting relationships with other blind students and receive mentorship from young, successful, blind professionals.



Independence

Virtual, day, and weekend-long workshops and community activities where you develop skills such as travel, home management, and technology.



Self-Advocacy

Learn how to communicate effectively with teachers and employers to ensure you receive the tools you need to succeed in school and the workplace.



Employment

Reach your educational and career goals through resume and interview workshops, job readiness skills, and internship or volunteer placement.
