Lower Wordsign Rules

in, enough, be, his, was, were

BE HIS WAS & WERE- look similar to punctuation and indicators (be=semi-colon, his=opening quote, was= closing quote, were= the inches indicator) **Because they can be confused, they are not used in direct contact with punctuation that has only lower dots.**

You can only use *be, his, was, were* when they are standing alone.

Samples:

That was his.

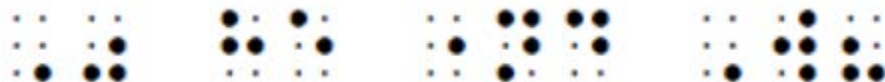


(That was his.)



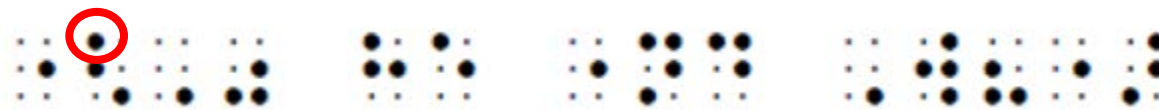
Can't use **be, was, his, were** at the end of a sentence near punctuation even if followed by an indicator with an upper dot. **In & en break this rule** since they can't be confused with punctuation!

Was he named Will?



A **capital indicator & terminator**, although is in the lower part of the cell, **is ignored** when deciding whether or not to use a contraction.

(Was he named Will?)



You CAN use these contractions if they are next to indicators that have a dot in the upper cell AS LONG AS they are not touching lower cell punctuation.

CANNOT use *was* in the following sentence because there are no upper dots in the symbol sequence if you do.

“Was he named Will?”



CANNOT USE BE, HIS, WAS & WERE NEXT TO A HYPHEN , DASH OR SLASH

He was-is going to the store.



He was/is going, if I can.



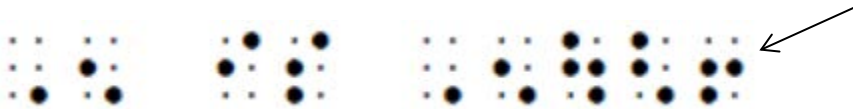
Enough & in braille rules



Since *enough* and *in* CANNOT be confused with punctuation, it can be used next to lower cell punctuation as long as the sequence contains an upper dot.

Enough is Enough!

Spell it out because it didn't have any upper dots in the sequence contracted



(Enough is enough)



Contract because 'enough' in both cases is touching a parenthesis that has an upper dot)

[Enough is enough!]

Can use *enough* and *in* next to lower cell punctuation and has an upper dot in the bracket



Quirky Rules

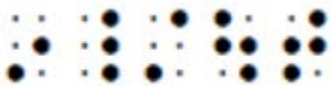
NEVER USE *enough* next to a slash

USE *in* next to a slash

USE *enough* when it is standing along

USE *in* wherever it might occur as long as there is an upper dot in the symbol sequence it is in

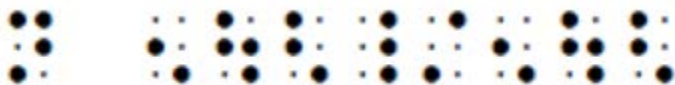

Use in & enough before or after a hyphen or dash; however, if there are no dots in the upper cells, spell the word out after the hyphen/dash

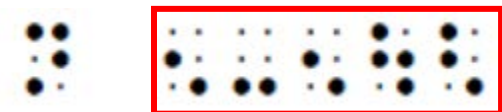

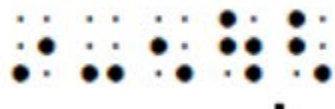


In the next 4 examples, you have to spell the second lower word sign out because there would have been not dots in the upper cells of this symbol sequence if you used the contraction

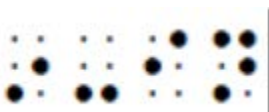
